Please note we will be closed from 24th December until Monday 4th January 2021.

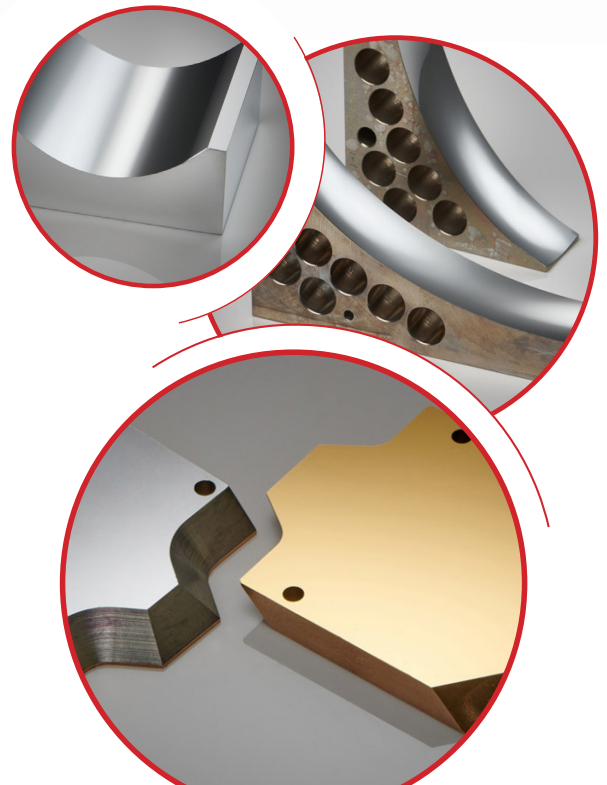


Looking ahead to 2021
